Gustine Suffers Nightmare on Friday the 13th

How would you like to score 80 points and not win? That's the nightmare Gustine's living after Friday's 86-80 loss to Brookesmith.

The Tigers racked up plenty of yards and touchdowns, but fell too far behind to make up the difference. At one point, Gustine trailed by 42 points.

Chris Grimes had another big night, rushing for almost 300 yards and scoring three special teams touchdowns. (see details below)

Brookesmith on the other hand is now averaging 76 points per game, behind Sophomore QB Eric Clawson, after two big showings.

Milford had a scary night, not putting private school opponent Cornerstone Academy of Waxahachie away until the final play of the game.

The Bulldog defense is living up to their

preseason billing though, allowing a stingy 13 points per game.

Speaking of defense, top-ranked Whitharral has not allowed a single point this fall.

The Panthers are led by Jason Dobrolyny (26 tackles, one sack) and Michael Lopez (20 tackles, four sacks).

Both #29 Rochester and #52 Oglesby have not allowed a point either.

On the flip side of that figure is Paint Creek, who has not scored yet this season, despite being a playoff team in each of the last two years.

Two-time defending state champions, the Amherst Bulldogs, scored this week against Southland, but are still without a victory.

On a more positive note, district eight is really playing well. The district is 11-3 overall and two of those losses are to district opponents.

Friday Night Heroes

Chillicothe's Henry Kendrick has been living up to his preseason selection to the Huntress Report's All-State Team. The star running back ran for 372 yards on 18 carries and five touchdowns in Friday's win over Woodson. After a Joe Blevins' interception at the one-yard line, with ten seconds remaining before the half, Kendrick went around end for a 79-yard score. Kendrick also had 254 yards and four touchdowns in week one to bring his total to 626 yards and nine touchdowns for the young season.... Gustine's Chris Grimes also continued to roll up the yardage. Grimes had 25 rushes for 282 yards, bringing his season total to 463 yards. Grimes also returned a fumble and two kickoffs for touchdowns.... Eric Clawson of Brookesmith completed 29 of 45 passes for 475 yards in the Mustangs' 86-80 win over Gustine. Clawson also had 181 yards on 16 carries. His most remarkable stat may be his eleven touchdowns (four rushing and seven passing). Clawson threw for 370 yards on 32 of 37 passing in week one against Rochelle.... Brookesmith's Jack Stockman was on the receiving end of eight passes for 104 yards and 4 touchdowns this weekend... Justin Hill of Westbrook completed only three of four passes for 49 yards against Union, but all three went for touchdowns. Justin also returned a 65 yard kickoff for a score... Justin's brother Casey Hill scored four touchdowns (punt ret., two rushing, and one rec.)... Top-ranked Whitharral's Justin Stracener intercepted three passes against Wilson....
