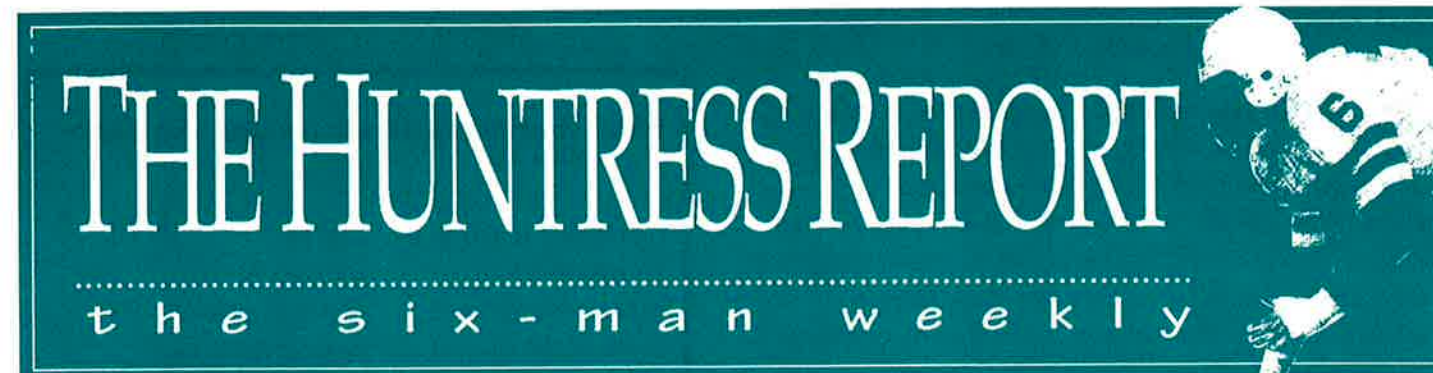

Owls Top Bulldogs

In a game between two top offenses with premier backs, the Covington Owls outlasted the Mullin Bulldogs 66-62.

The Covington explosion was led by Blue Willis, Charlie Tingle, and Mike Fitzpatrick. Willis rushed for 159 yards on 13 carries and also had an 80 yard kickoff return for a touchdown. He sealed the victory with a 25 yard TD run with 1:12 remaining to give the Owls a 66-54 lead.

Mullin answered back with a 25 yard TD pass from Petey Salaiz to Eric Berron with :16 left, but it was not enough, as the Owls recovered the ensuing onside kick.

Salaiz carried the Bulldogs, who were without starting

QB/DE Charlie Smith, who had orthoscopic surgery last week. Salaiz had 307 yards on 35 carries to bolster his state leading total to 1044 yards in four games.

Despite his performance, Salaiz felt, "the difference was defense. We couldn't stop them."

Covington had too many weapons. When Mullin contained Willis, Fitzpatrick would always find the open man, usually Tingle. Fitzpatrick threw for four TD's, while Tingle caught three of those and ran for another. Friday was Willis' birthday and did he ever celebrate, rushing for three TD's the KO return to cap off what he called, "the greatest birthday present ever!"

Two coaches accomplished a huge milestone Friday night. Covington's CW Williams and Cherokee's Roddy Maddox both won their 190th six-man football games....Petey Salaiz continued his run through the competition, rushing for 307 yards on 35 carries. He also had a 65 yard KO return for a score and played a part in 56 of Mullin's 62 points. Petey now has 1044 yards on 96 carries this season. He also leads the Bulldogs in tackles....Strawn's Justin Lawrence was incorrectly credited with 746 yards last week, he actually had 646. This weekend Justin had 6 carries for 232 yards against Paint Rock, a whopping 38.7 per carry average. Justin has 878 yards on 46 carries, a 19.1 average.... Covington's Mike Fitzpatrick was 17 of 24 passing against Mullin with 299 yards and 4 TD's....Strawn's Mike Camfield had another fumble recover for a TD. He now has 6, with 2 going for TD's....Sha Copeland, another Strawn teammate, returned his 3rd interception for a TD Friday....
