Who's Number One?

I am constantly being asked: who's the best team in the state?

My initial thought is to respond: does it matter right now?

That may seem a little terse, but it really doesn't matter. Most coaches agree that the only time they want to be ranked number one is at the end of the season. Sure it's nice to be recognized as a great team, but winning it all is what it's all about.

This year, two teams, Whitharral and Gordon have both held the top spot in The Huntress Six-Man Rankings.

Whitharral was on top the first three weeks, as Gordon kept creeping closer. The Longhorns finally overtook the Panthers in week four, only to fall back to second last week.

The main reasons for the flip-flop is the strength of schedule factor and the 45-point rule in six-man.

The rating system gauges strength of schedule versus point differential. Sometimes a team should win by a theoretical 70 points, but can only win by 45. The winning teams is not penalized, but they also cannot pick up any points.

That's exactly what has happened to with Gordon and Whitharral.

As for who I feels is best, I still like Whitharral.

Incidentally, Gordon and Whitharral have only met once in the history of the schools. In 1981, the year Whitharral won it all, they defeated Gordon in the state semifinals, 54-18.

Friday Night Heroes

Luis Delgadillo continued his torrid pace, leading the Panther Creek Panthers to a 60-0 win over Novice. Delgadillo 268 total yards and scored six rushing touchdowns. He also returned a punt 45 yards for another score.... May's Brandon Purcell led the Tigers with 229 yards on 24 carries and three touchdowns.... Sanderson defeated Buena Vista 51-20, behind Jesse Martinez' four touchdown passes and Mike Sanchez' 70 interception return for a score. Sanderson scored the final 30 points of the game.... Trinidad's Damien Jackson had 13 rushes for 262 yards and four touchdowns against Blum. Jackson also caught one pass that resulted in another score. For the season Jackson has 1128 yards on 83 carries and 21 touchdowns.... Cherokee's Steven Craft rushed for touchdown scores of 10, 20, and 25 to lead the Indians in a 34-22 victory over Rochelle.... Whitharral's Brandon Rodgers has scored 19 touchdowns and kicked 22 extra points, for a total of 158 points....

Megargel, Star Forfeit Games

It's that time of year where teams around the state start to forfeit games.

That's the nature of six-man football, played in towns with limited supplies of players, unless of course, you're in Zephyr.

If you start with 12 players, and lose a few to injury and a few to grades, all of a sudden your out a bodies.

This week it was Megargel and Star, while last week both Sierra Blanca and Morgan were involved in forfeits.

Megargel played a 'JV' team that was victorious over Paint Creek this weekend. The Mustangs were forced to do this because of a lack of numbers and a need to play ineligible players.

Star is also playing a 'JV' schedule because they will be using players who do not qualify for varsity competition. This weekend the Tigers forfeited to

Brookesmith.

Last week, Sierra Blanca forfeited its game with Sanderson. This week the Vaqueros found some new players and were able to field a team Friday night against Balmorhea.

Morgan's situation is different because they used an ineligible player by accident at the end of a game.

statistical notes on forfeited games:

★ Games actually played are considered for The Huntress Six-Man Rankings.

Megargel does not get credit for statistics played by their 'JV' squad, but Paint Creek's loss on the field does affect their ranking. The statistics and points from the Morgan-Blum game do count toward both teams' rankings.

★ In games played, but forfeited, coaches

who lost the game on the field, but win by forfeit do not get credit for a win and are charged with a loss, eventhough the team gets credit for a win. Coaches are considered players in the game and their on field statistics count as do the players.

★ In games not played, teams and coaches get credit for a win or loss, and are not penalized or given credit for points scored/allowed.

Brookesmith, Sanderson, Star, and Sierra Blanca count thier scoring and defensive averages based on one fewer game than their record shows. The two points for a forfeit does not count toward that total.

★ These ruling are based on the NCAA Statisticians' Manual, which states that per-game statistics should be based on games actually played.
