Hill's teammate, Sam Lawrence, also carried the ball 13 times for 107 yards and three touchdowns.... Lazbuddie's Justin St. Clair carried the ball 16 times for 114 yards and a touchdown vs. Silverton. He also completed seven of ten passes for 163 yards and three touchdowns.... Paint Rock's Seth Becker had 150 yards rushing and a 43-yard scoring run vs. Cherokee.... Panther Creek's Luis Delgadillo carried the ball only five times for 108 yards and three touchdowns. Trey Sikes added 80 yards on five more carries, two more touchdowns, and a 3-yard fumble return for a score.... In private school action, Abilene Christian's John Estes IV threw for 420 yards and seven touchdowns in a big 70-20 win over Harvest Christian.... Paint Creek's Chris Williams had some big runs. Rory has also caught 5 passes for 177 yards and three tds- a remarkable 35.4 average per catch. He also has 3 punt returns for 122 yards and 2 tds, 8 ints (1 for a score), 86 tackles, and 2 fumble recoveries (1 for a score).... Damien Jackson (Trinidad)- Jackson has 98 carries for 1417 yards and 26 touchdowns.... Justin St. Clair (Lazbuddie)- Has 860 yards and 10 td's on 115 carries. Justin has completed 51 of 91 passes for 12 tds and 795 yards, with only 1 int.... Whitharral's defense has allowed only 30 points all season. The Panthers are giving up a mere 135 yards per game, almost evenly balanced between rushing and passing. Jason Dobrovny has 97 tackles, but Michael Lopez is catching up with 86 of his own....
