The Times They Are a Changin'

At least five teams that have been regulars to post-season play lost this weekend and will likely stay at home.

Lazbuddie, Dell City, Guthrie, Zephyr, and Loraine all lost and saw their hopes for playoff berths almost completely disappear.

The Longhorns found themselves outgunned, 73-42, by a Whitharral team that has become the surprise story in six-man this season. The speedy Panthers (8-0) now get a shot this week to really see what they are made of against top-ranked Amherst.

Dell City, another perennial playoff squad, and a finalist two years ago, saw their playoff hopes disappear at the

hands of Balmorhea. The Bears can get in with a win over Grandfalls-Royalty.

Guthrie lost to Rochester 28-21 and can only make the playoffs if they defeat a solid Jayotn team, throwing the district into a three-way tie.

The Zephyr Bulldogs fell to an explosive Sidney team that needs only to defeat Gustine to earn a playoff berth. Sidney trailed 30-22 at the half, but only allowed Zephyr 12 second half points.

Loraine lost, 52-6, to Highland and has seen their season crumble since losing Cory Woodell two weeks ago. The Bulldogs, a preseason lock, must now stay at home.
