Highwood Wins 5th Straight Montana Crown

Highwood won their fifth-straight Montana six-man state championship, as they defeated Brady, 21-19 in Highwood last Saturday.

It was the 38th straight victory for Highwood (10-0), dating back to the 1992 season.

Kam Knudsen led the way for the Mountaineers, rushing for 153 yards and two touchdowns.

Trailing 21-13 in the fourth quarter, Brady pulled within two points on a 4-yard run by Kurt Thaut with 3:37 remaining.

The Bulldogs, however, missed a chance to tie the game when the conversion kick failed.

Brady (8-2), whose only two losses this season came at the hands of Highwood, hand one final chance, as they recovered a fumble at their own 34-yard line with 1:54 remaining.

The Bulldogs drove to the Highwood 24-yard line, before turning the ball over on downs.

Leading 14-13 at halftime, Highwood took a 21-13 on a 2-yard run by Eddie Brooke in the third quarter.

Computer Line: Whitharral by 45

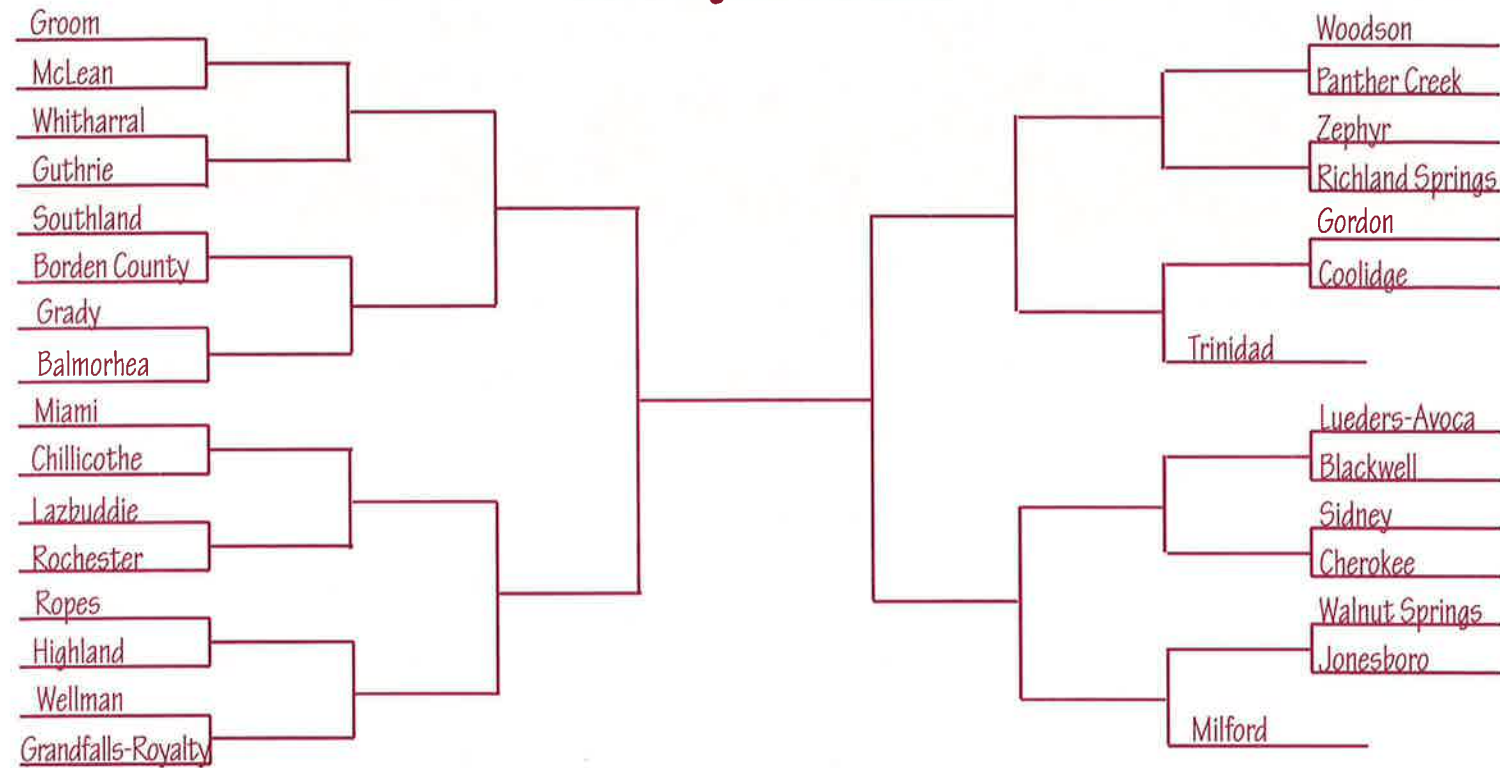
#6 Southland(9-1) vs. #13 Borden County (6-4)

How They Matchup

#17 Grady(9-1) vs. #15 Balmorhea (8-1)
Thoughts: Grady's offense is led by RB Brad Cox, who is a threat to run or pass. On defense expect Cody Peugh and Joey Rivas to be involved in the action. Balmorhea is a speed team whose only setback came at the hands of Grandfalls. their explosive offense has averaged over 55 points per game.
Computer Line: Balmorhea by 2

#26 Miami(8-2) vs. #10 Chillicothe (8-2)
Thoughts: Miami's team leaders are LB Jared Neighbors, RB Jammy Murray, QB Marshall Flowers, and LB Dustin Howard. Chillicothe's threat is the tough Henry Kenrick, who is backed up by a host of players, including Sonny Smart.
Computer Line: Chillicothe by 19

#12 Lazbuddie (9-1) vs. #20 Rochester (8-2)
Thoughts: Justin St. Clair leads a Lazbuddie squad whose only loss came in week nine to Whitharral. Brice Foster and Chris Smith will also be in the mix for Lazbuddie. Claude Baker and Charlie Parks lead Rochester in the 'Battle of the Steers'.

#29 Ropes (6-4) vs. #9 Highland (9-1)
Thoughts: Highland has a two-headed running monster in the names of Cody Muncy and Jacob Ballenger. Ropes has Greg Knight, Jorge Gomez, and Frank Diaz.

#37 Wellman (8-2) vs. #14 Grandfalls-Royalty (10-0)
Thoughts: Sean Rowden is the key to the Wellman attack. For three years he has been the go-to guy. Grandfalls makes the playoffs for the first time ever as a six-man school and the school's first district title since 1980. Expect great things from Alfonso Marquez, Roy Vasquez, Corey Moore, and Tim Thomas, as they lead one of only four undefeated schools into the playoffs.

#11 Woodson (9-1) vs. #16 Panther Creek (7-2)
Thoughts: Woodson will go as far as Rory Peacock can take them. The all-state candidate has been awesome this season on both sides of the ball. Panther Creek has the two great running backs: Trey Sikes and Luis Delgadillo. Miguel Guijosa and Brent Dawson are two more team leaders for a squad that reached the semifinals last fall.

#4 Zephyr (9-1) vs. #38 Richland Springs (4-5)
Thoughts: Zephyr is stacked with talent. Jon Temple, Dusty Miller, Chad King, Jason Hatchett, et al, haven't looked back since their week one loss to Gordon. Bulldogs toppled RS 36-8 in week four. Richland Springs has talent, but has never quite gotten off the ground. Regan McKinnerney, Casey Gossett, and Bucky Lusty lead the Coyotes.

#2 Gordon (10-0) vs. #33 Coolidge (7-3)
