O'Brien Captures First Six-Man Crown

On Friday, December 8, 1972, the O'Brien Bulldogs defeated the Jarrell Cougars 60-14, to capture the first ever six-man state championship in Coleman.

The Bulldogs were coached by C.H. Underwood and completed the season at a perfect 12-0. Jarrell finished at 10-2.

Danny DelHierro led O'Brien with an amazing 390 yards rushing and six touchdowns. The tiny 140 pound back was unstoppable, punishing the Jarrell defense for 273 in the first half alone.

Two Thousand fans witnessed the game, as the Bulldogs put the Cougars away with 3:48 still remaining in the third period.

In 1972, teams were finally allowed to advance past regional round in all classifications.

Jarrell's Patrick Palousek ran for a score and threw for another to help their cause, but it wasn't enough.

The Cougars in general could only muster up 153 yards in total offense, compared to the

511 yards the Bulldogs compiled. The Bulldogs had 458 yards in rushing alone.

Louis Conn scored two touchdowns, including the clincher. Rayland Hayes kicked the extra point to seal it.
