#3 Milford (11-0) vs. #17 Jonesboro (10-1)

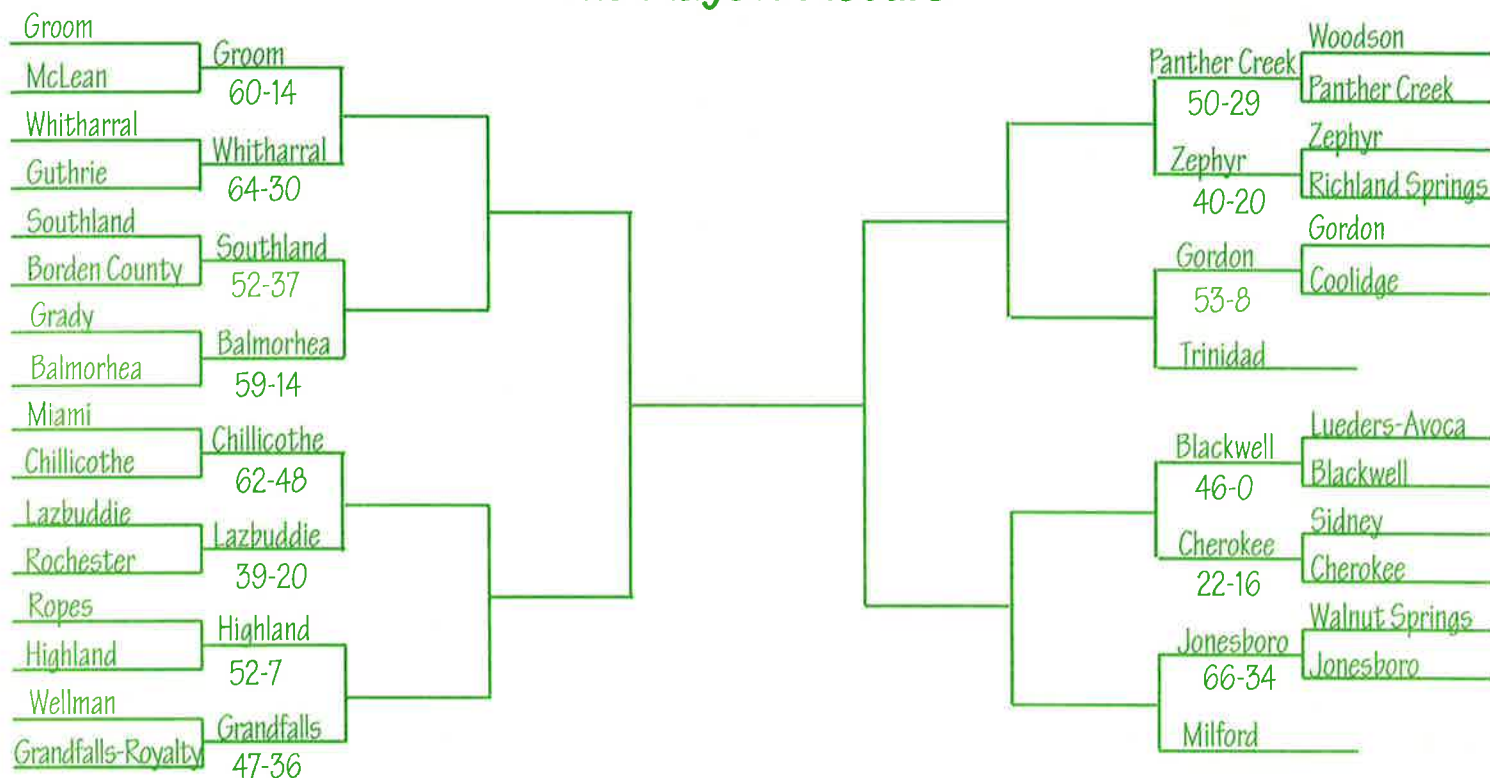
