AMHERST IS BIG DOG!

It was a cold night for football as the Amherst Bulldogs battled back from an early 20-6 deficit to upset Milford 30-20 and became the 1994 Texas Six-Man State Champions. Led by Dewayne Miles 159 rushing yards, the Bulldogs wore out a bigger Milford squad, scoring 24 unanswered points.

Milford started out strong, scoring quickly in the first quarter on two Norman Singleton runs. Amherst came back though and allowed Singleton only 29 second half yards. Amherst's tough defense forced Milford to leave their game plan as they attempted a season record 18 passes. The Dawgs offensive attack kept Milford off balance with strategic Chris bishop to Ryan McNabb passes.

For three quarters it was literally a dog fight before Amherst scratched their way to two big fourth quarter scores by Miles.

Amherst finished the season 13-1-1, while Milford finished at 12-1.
