It Won't Be Loraine

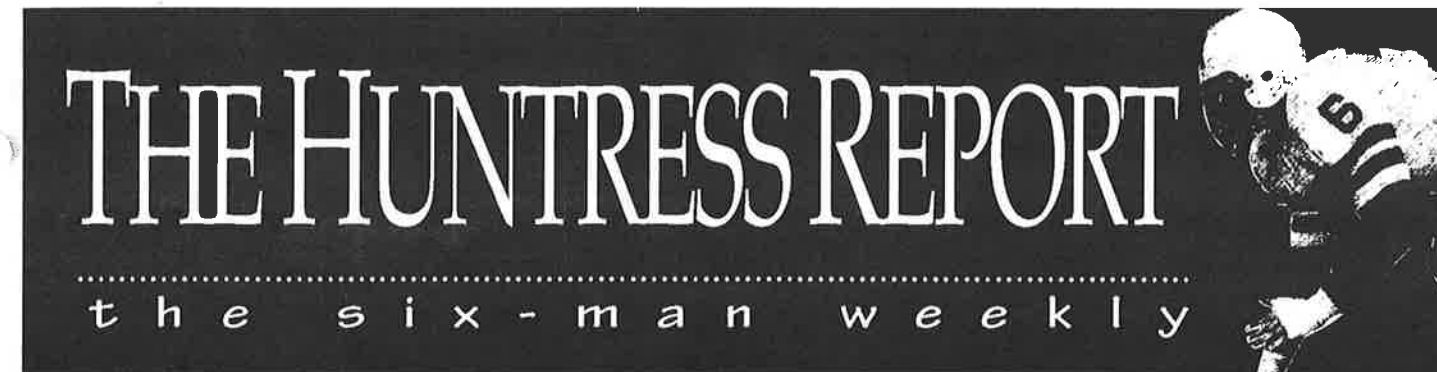
I promise next week's game of the week won't have **Loraine** in it. I swear it won't even though they'll be hosting the top ranked private, **Midland Christian**.

The Battle In Brownwood

Saturday night in Brownwood's Gordon Wood Stadium the top two teams in Texas and Colorado will knock heads in front of what could be the largest crowd in six-man football history. The top-rated Mullin Bulldogs from Texas hope to hold on to their mythical National Title hopes when they face the Weldon Valley, Colorado Warriors.

Mullin returns all its starters from a 12-1 team that lost to state finalist Milford 32-30 in the state quarter-finals.

The Bulldogs are lead by All-American running back Petey Salaiz. Salaiz is a speed deamon who led all classifications in rushing last season. The defense is led by all-staters Bobby Teague and Charlie Smith. Both are line-

men with speed and like to hit hard. Salaiz leads the Mullin linebackers. This is a solid defense which has twice shut out a Richland Springs team that averaged almost 50 points a game in the last two seasons.

Weldon Valley, Colorado's top team, returns five players on both sides from a team that was 11-1 and a Colorado state finalist.

The Warriors are led by Denver Post all-staters Shawn Loos, a junior QB/DB, Travis Shaver, a senior RB/DB, and Chuck Thompson, also a senior RB/DB.

WV looks to run a balanced attack, utilizing all the players on the field.

How About an Upset or Two ?

This was quite a wild first weekend of the season. We should have expected the shockers immediately when the front came through and cooled off the summer heat.

None was a bigger shock than the Rochester Steers upset of then ranked #11 Paint Creek. This Creek had high hopes coming into the season. Another big one was Union's 62-38 disposal of Cotton Center.

It may not come as too big a surprise, but Guthrie's 60-54 win over then #6 Chillicothe sent a loud message that the Jaguars aren't rolling over for anyone.

Players of note:

Strawn's **Justin Lawrence** had 227 yards rushing on 21 carries, including 4 td's, leading the Greyhounds to 357 yards rushing as a team. Aaron Orsini also had 9 carries for 101 yds.

Buckholts' **Gary Talafuse** had 16 carries for 232 yards and 2 td's.

Moran's John Martinez had 7 rushes for 151 yds and 2 td's and was 8 for 16 passing with 149 yds. and 3 td's, for a total of 300 yds in total offense.

It was also rumored that Lueders-Avooca's **Matt Strickland** rushed for over 350 yards in their loss to Highland.
