### Canadian Bandits Hope to Steal Victory From #1 Gordon

The Bjorkdale Bandits, from Saskatchewan Canada, travel to Gordon this weekend to face the top-ranked Longhorns.

Bjorkdale, who is coached by Rocky Chysyk, is the defending Class A Provincial Champion.

The town of Bjorkdale is located about 180 miles northeast of Saskatoon.

Eighteen players and six adults will make the journey from the "great white north", including E Landon Welter, C Scott Kehrig, RB Doug Bartsch, and RB Clayton Seguin.

Gordon coaches expect to see the Bandits run an option-I and the spread to varying degrees.

Six-man veterans will be in for a surprise

as Canadian rules will be played for half the game.

The biggest differences are that the quarterback is eligible to run with the ball from the direct snap and teams need only gain ten yards for a first down- and on only three downs.

Other rule changes include: only receiving one point for a conversion, whether kicked or not. Conversions are also spotted at the 5-yard line, instead of the three.

A one-point 'rouge' is awarded for kickoffs and punts which are not fielded.

The Bandits arrive in Texas Thursday night and will be hosted at the homes of families

## Cotton Center- Dawson Battle to Last Tie?

The Dawson Dragons and the Cotton Center Elks fought to a 44-44 tie this past Friday, in what could be the last tie we see in six-man.

When district begins in a few weeks, districts have the choice of playing with the new tiebreaker system, adapted by the UIL and college football this season.

Teams are not allowed to utilize the new system until dis-

trict, allowing referees time to completely understand and implement new rule changes.

Cotton Center lead 44-32, but Dawson answered with an Alfredo Ramirez 24-yard run with 5:19 left in the game. The kick failed.

Kiley Bennett then ran 47-yards for the tying score with 2:42 remaining. The kick also failed.

Dawson held Cotton Center

on four plays and got the ball at their own 16-yard line with one minute left left.

They moved out to the 30-yard line, but couldn't convert on fourth down.

Cotton Center had four seconds, but didn't capitalize.

There was also a 20 minute delay, after half of the stadium lights went out in the closing seconds. Dawson moves to 2-1-1, while CC is 1-2-1.

Justin Hill of Westbrook completed 13 of 22 passes for 172 yards passing. Justin also returned a kickoff 70 yards for a score.... Grandfalls-Royalty's Corey Moore had only four carries, but ran for 101 yards and a touchdown. Moore also threw two touchdown passes and caught another. His teammate, Alfonso Marcus, rushed for three touchdowns, caught a 42-yard pass for another, and returned an interception 53-yards for one more... Dell City's Abel Valles completed 31 of 43 passes for 456 yards, five touchdown's, and two interceptions.... Jesse Martinez of Sanderson was 13 of 18 for 228 yards and four touchdowns.... Second ranked Whitharral isn't putting up huge numbers, they're keeping them off. The Panthers still haven't been scored on yet. MLB Jason Dobrovny leads the team with 40 tackles. The team allowed Follett only one first down and Loop managed the one foot line, but couldn't get in.
