



The Playoff Picture

- district 1-** Samnorwood is champ. Miami is runner up.
- district 2-** Amherst is champ. Whitharral is runner up.
- district 3-** Southland has clinched a playoff berth. If they beat Meadow, they win the title. If Meadow, New Home, and Wilson tie for second, it's a coin flip. Meadow wins a tie over Wilson, New Home wins a tie over Meadow, and Wilson wins a tie over New Home. If Meadow beats Southland, they take the title and Southland is second.
- district 4-** If Jayton beats Guthrie, Jayton takes district title and Rochester is second. If Guthrie beats Jayton, it becomes a three way tie and goes to a coin flip.
- district 5-** Klondike and Sands play for the title.
- district 6-** Westbrook and Highland play for the title.
- district 8-** Balmorhea and Buena Vista play for the title.
- district 9-** If Chillicothe beats Benjamin, they win the district title and Northside is second. If Benjamin wins, it's a three way tie.

- district 10-** Woodson is champ. Paint Creek is runner up.
- district 11-** Panther Creek is champ. Blackwell and Paint Rock play for second place.
- district 12-** Mullin and Sidney play for the title.
- district 13-** Gordon and Strawn play for the district title.
- district 14-** If Covington, Trinidad, and Milford all win, it goes to a coin flip for first and second. That would mean a 9-1 team stays home.
- district 15-** If Richland Springs and Cherokee win, RS is champ and Cherokee is second. If RS and Rochelle win, RS is champ and it's a three way tie for second. If Brookesmith and Cherokee win, it's a three way tie for first. And if Brookesmith and Rochelle win, Brookesmith is district champ and RS is second.
- district 16-** Jonesboro is champ. Buckholts is runner up.

## Last Chance To Get Into the Big Dance

Twenty of thirty spots have been filled for the playoffs. With one final weekend of action left, a group of 18 teams fight for a chance to join this elite bunch.

One of the most interesting stories involves district 14, where Milford thumped Trinidad 45-0, turning that race into a mess.

Chris Pendleton ran back the opening KO for a td and didn't look back. He was 4 of 8 passing for 61 yds with 2 td's and rushed 7 times for 125 yds and 2 more td's. Kinta Cook ran the ball 8 times for 178 yards and 3 td's.

It is likely that Milford, Trinidad, and Covington will all finish the season with 9-1 records. That would put fate in

the hands of a coin flip and leave a deserving team home for the playoffs.

Covington and Milford have relatively easy home games against Bynum and Fruitvale, respectively. Trinidad, however, has a tougher road and must travel to Coolidge to stay in the three way race.

Elsewhere, Sidney qualified for the playoffs for the first time since 1966, with a 88-59 victory over Gustine.

Craig Steele was 12 of 24 passing, for 246 yards and 6 td's. He also ran 18 times for 173 yards and 4 more td's.

Steele's main receiver, Reed Trospen, eclipsed the 1000 yard mark receiving. Trospen caught 5 passes for 128 yards, to bring his total to 1020 yards on 45 receptions.

State-leading passer, Bryan Nichols of Cotton Center, had another big night Friday. Nichols was 21 of 42 for 319 yards passing, with 4 td's and 4 int's. He also rushed 12 times for 77 yards....Dewayne Miles of Amherst continues to have impressive numbers. Miles had 157 yards and 5 td's on only 11 carries, in a big win over Whitharral. With his size, speed, and attitude Dewayne has been very deserving of the attention he is starting to receive. The Texas Tech coaches have even visited Amherst.... Klondike QB Tanner Ethridge was 6 of 9 for a whopping 171 yards. That's a nice 28.5 yards per completion average.... Buckholts RB Gary Talafuse had a big night Friday, rushing for 161 yards and 4 td's on only 10 carries....Richard Ruzicka of Buckholts intercepted 3 passes, returning one for a td, in the Badgers' 47-2 win over Cranfills Gap.... Woodson suffered some setbacks as preseason all-stater Rory Peacock and Jody Watson both broke their hands and are out at least three weeks. Losing Peacock is an enormous loss for the Cowboys, particularly since he was their QB and DB.... On a positive note, Jimmy Miles has been a pleasant surprise for Woodson. Miles rushed for 201 yards and 3 td's on 10 carries. He also returned a KO 45 yards for another td and had 14.5 tackles.... Petey Salaiz continued his drive for 10,000 yards Friday against May. Petey rushed for 187 yards on 16 carries and 2 td's. That leaves him at 9873 yards for his career.
